From the A449 Kidderminster to Worcester Road turn into Stanklyn Lane by the Mare and Colt Public House (Please note limited 13'3" bridge height) and continue for approx. 1 mile, the sale field being found on the left.

From the A448 Kidderminster to Bromsgrove Road turn into Stanklyn Lane and continue around the bends, the sale field then being found after a short distance on the right.

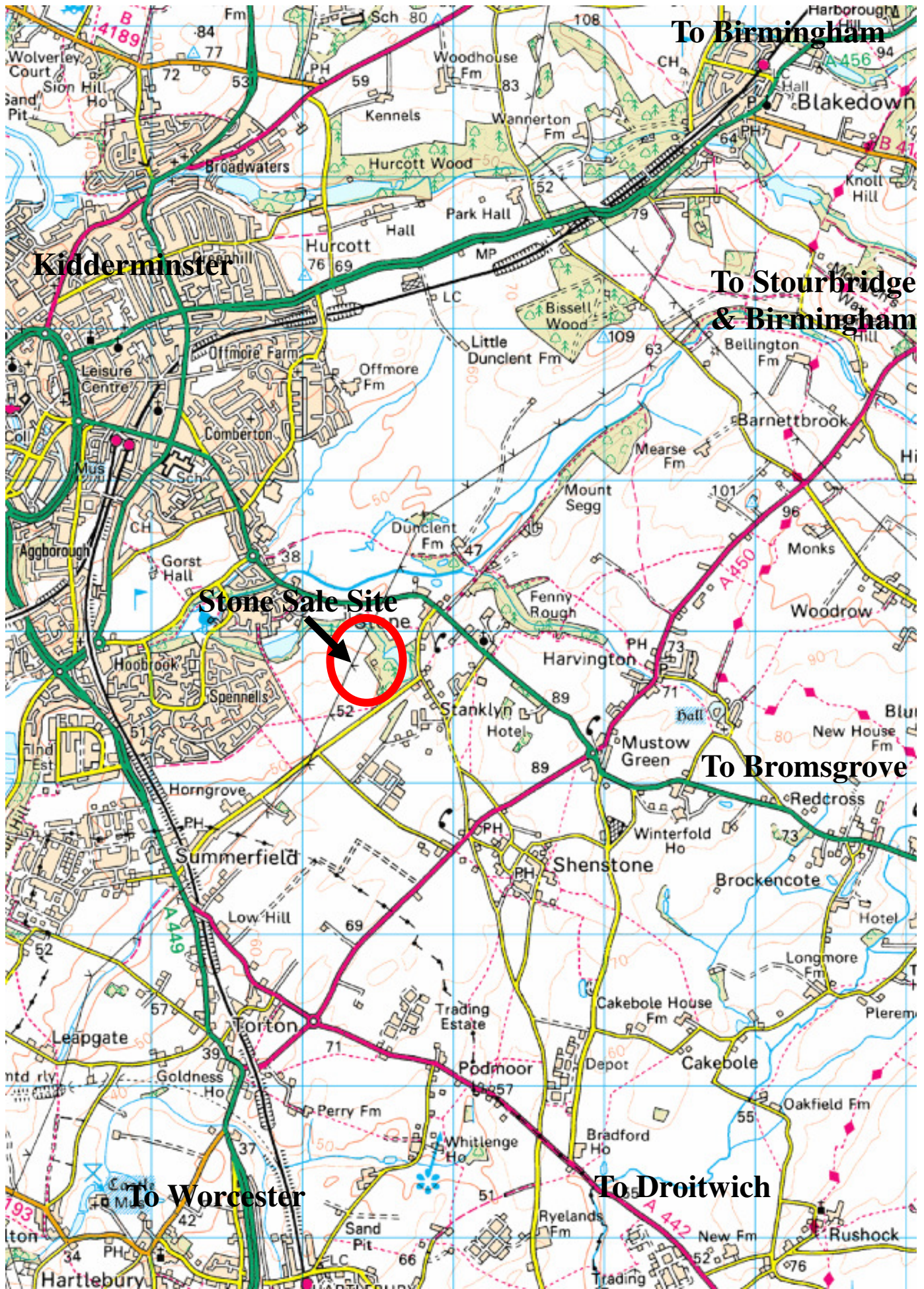
CONDITIONS OF SALE
